

Q & A for Registration of 2015 CCCB Summer Retreat

1. Where is the retreat location? When is the date?

Time: August 14 Friday to 16 Sunday, 2015

Location: Skycroft Retreat Center, 9621 Frostown Rd, Middletown, MD 21769

2. Who are the speakers for the retreat?

The Retreat will hold two sections: in English and in Mandarin, The speaker for the Mandarin section is Rev. Zhiqiu Xu, who is associate professor at Columbia International University. The English speaker is Rev. Daniel Au, who was our retreat speaker in 2008.

3. I need a ride to reach the retreat center.

Please indicate as such on the registration form and the Retreat planning committee will coordinate with you.

4. When does the registration start?

The registration date will be June 7 to July 26. Only 150 spots are available and is a first-come, first-serve process.

5. How about the fee?

Different than the previous years, the 2015 retreat is **FREE to CCCB members and their families**. There will be a deposit fee (see below for more info).

6. What if my plans change after registering such that I cannot attend the retreat?

A **refundable** deposit of \$50 per person (four years old and up) will be required for registration. The deposit will be returned after attending the retreat. **July 26** is the deadline for cancellation, no shows or plan changes **after July 26, 2015** will void the refund. The deposit checks are payable to CCCB, and please mark "Retreat deposit" on it.

7. Could I commute to the retreat?

Of course, you can. Due to the reservation limit of 150 people who can stay overnight onsite, those attendees have to choose commuting if the reservation limit is reached. You have the option to commute. All commuting attendees are also required to register. The deposit for day attendee is \$30 per person (four years old and up). The commuting attendee deposit is also refundable by the same policy as the regular attendee.

8. What if I'm not a CCCB member?

If you are a Christian, and have been at CCCB more than three months, we encourage you to enroll membership immediately. Else, the cost for non-member is \$130 per person (four years old and up), and \$30 /day per person (four years old and up) for day attendee, payable at time of registration. If there is financial challenge, assistance is available - simply make this known to your CCCB fellowship group leader. July 26 is the last day for cancellation of non-member attendee.

9. Could I request special accommodations?

Yes, please indicate as such on the registration form. We will do our best to accommodate those needs. There are two types of accommodations at the Skycroft Retreat Center: Motel rooms with two full-size beds and Lodges with bunk-style beds. Only 18 Motel rooms have been made available for us and so most attendees will be in Lodges. The Motel rooms will be for attendees who have special needs, the elderly, and large families. The Retreat planning team reserves the right for room assignments.

10. I am willing to give offering for the retreat. How to do it?

As a new church ministry, the estimated budget of the retreat based on the previous years is about \$25,000. This includes lodging, all meals, retreat materials (i.e. program booklet, name tags, etc.), event reservations (i.e. swimming pool, etc.), amongst other items. All financial support will rely on faith offerings from Brothers and Sisters. Please pray for this ministry. Offering checks are payable to "CCCB" (please mark "for retreat" on the check).
